NOTICE ABOUT ARRIVAL IN AND DEPARTURE FROM NEPAL

Considering the declining trend of the circulation of coronavirus (Covid-19) in Nepal in recent days, the Government of Nepal has issued a revised travel advisory for the incoming and outbound passengers, which came into force immediately. The following are the new provisions:

Requirements:

(A) Vaccine Certificate:

Passengers entering Nepal by air or land are required to submit certificate/s confirming full vaccination against Covid-19. Any passenger failing to submit such a vaccine certificate will have to submit a Covid-19 test (RT-PCR, True NAAT Gene Expert) report conforming negative result, which should be obtained not before 72 hours from the check-in time if travelling by air or not before 72 hours from the time of arriving at the border entry point;

(B) Online Arrival Form:

Passengers are advised to fill in the International Traveler Online Arrival Form, save it and carry the barcode generated by the system after the form is saved.

(Please log in to www.ccmc.gov.np to access the form. Barcode is generated after saving the duly filled in the online registration form. Visitors are advised to fill in the Form after they confirmed the air ticket or receive the PCR report well before they leave home for the airport to avoid the last-minute hassle.)

For Passengers travelling to other countries from Nepal:

The concerned airlines are required to inform their passengers about the Covid-19 related health protocol in the country the passengers are travelling to. The passengers are also advised to check the airlines they are travelling with about the health protocol and carry the required documents accordingly.

Previous Travel Advisory/Notices revoked:

Travel advisories/notices issued before have been revoked.
