

His Excellency Mr. Dipak ADHIKARI
Ambassador of Nepal

H. E. Mr. Dipak Adhikari arrived in Paris to assume his responsibility as Ambassador of Nepal to the French Republic on 5 April 2019. He is concurrently accredited as Ambassador of Nepal to the Portuguese Republic and Principalities of Andorra and Monaco. Similarly, he also represents Nepal as Permanent Delegate to UNESCO.



After joining the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Nepal, Mr. Adhikari was sent to the Consulate General of Nepal in Kolkata as Attaché in February 1987 where he worked till March 1991. Later, he worked at the Protocol office, UN, International Organizations and International Law Divisions, the Passport office as well as the office of the Foreign Secretary.

From August 1988 to August 2002, he served as the Second Secretary and then the First Secretary at the Embassy of Nepal in Washington, DC.

He served as a Desk Officer at Europe America Division from September 2002 till August 2006. Between 2006 and May 2008, he served as the First Secretary at the Embassy of Nepal in New Delhi. After his return from India, he served as the Deputy Chief of Protocol in charge of passport and consular matters at the Ministry from June 2008 to December 2009.

From January 2010 to December 2013, he served as Counsellor/Deputy Chief of Mission at the Embassy of Nepal in Abu Dhabi, UAE. He worked at South Asia, Europe America, and West Asia and Africa Divisions at the Ministry after his return from the UAE. He also headed the Department of Consular Services for almost a year as Officiating Director General.

Prior to coming to Paris, he served as the Chief of Protocol for over two and half years at the Ministry.

He took part in various professional training programmes in Australia, Germany, Malaysia, and China.

He holds Bachelor in Law degree and also received a Master's degree in Political Science from Tribhuvan University in Nepal.

He is married to Sita who holds a Bachelor's degree in Political Science. They have a daughter and a son.
